Lilial/ Butylphenyl Methylpropional (CAS 80-54-6)

Butylphenyl Methylpropional (CAS 80-54-6), commonly known as Lilial, Lysmeral or p-BMHCA, is a **synthetic fragrance ingredient** used in many perfumes for cosmetic products as well as non-cosmetic products.

All Essity **scented cosmetic** products marketed in Europe (Consumer Tissue, Professional Hygiene, Feminine Care, Baby Care, INCO and Medical) as well as **scented** non-cosmetic products (Biocidal products, detergents, Absorbent Hygiene products, tissue products) do not contain Butylphenyl Methylpropional/ Lilial, neither is Lilial added in any other way. Lilial has been an Essity restricted ingredient since many years.

Lilial will be banned as of March 1st 2022 in cosmetic products. Essity cosmetic products marketed in Europe comply with the COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) 2021/1902 of 29 October 2021 amending Annexes II, III and V to Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the use in cosmetic products of certain substances classified as carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic for reproduction.

Essity products are manufactured in compliance with the relevant and actual valid regulations.
